## Board Meeting

The Regular board meeting was held on Wednesday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>. All the directors were in attendance except Ron Hoar. The Board approved the 2008 Budget with an increase of \$5 for the Annual Dues. Approved minutes are posted on the bulletin board. Board meetings are generally scheduled for the first Wednesday of each month and the exact date is posted on the notice board 48 hours prior to each meeting.

## 94.1 FM Celebrates 3<sup>rd</sup> Anniversary

Your Windover Farms radio station celebrates its 3<sup>rd</sup> year of broadcast service to the North Melbourne/Suntree/lower Viera communities this month. The station offered its first day of broadcasting on November 7, 2004--three and a half years after submitting an application to the FCC.

Our low power FM station provides a variety of music formats that appeal to adult listeners. The selections vary by hour to reflect the interests of a majority of listeners at that hour. Morning, noon and afternoon drive time periods have more of the current adult hits, early evening hours include much more smooth jazz and the mid morning and mid afternoon time

periods feature mostly "oldies".

"Our station is also focused on its responsibility as a noncommercial educational station to provide educational content--almost none of which is available in the area from the larger chain operated stations", says station manager Ron Hoar. "We try to let people know about issues and decisions being made by our County Commissioners, the Melbourne City Council (even though Windover is not part of the city), and the Brevard School Board." The station also includes frequent short reports on Earth and Sky worldwide environmental

subjects, health news from the Mayo Clinic, and a variety of interesting topics from AARP.

The station was initially best known to Windover residents, but with time word has spread so that "Now we probably have more listeners outside of Windover Farms than we have here", Ron said. "There are over 40,000 residents within about 3.5 miles of our antenna".

94.1 FM is totally dependent on its several volunteers for programming and technical needs and on the support of businesses and some individual donations for the financial

needs. None of the homeowner dues go to support the station, which requires a budget of around \$ 2,500 per year for music rights, electrical service and equipment needs and maintenance.

We're working on a very special "Evening Out Package" that we will award to some lucky listener to mark the completion of our three years on the air. Keep listening for more about this.

If you haven't been a regular listener--try us at 94.1 FM. Take us with you on your car radio as you take the kids to school or head off to work or shop.
